What are the Russell/Nomura Japan Equity Indexes?

The Russell/Nomura Japan Equity Indexes are Japanese equity indexes developed jointly by US-based Russell Investments and the Quantitative Research Center, Nomura Securities Co., Ltd.

Russell/Nomura Japan Equity Indexes have the following characteristics:

- They represent the entire Japanese equity market, in that component stocks are selected from among all listed stocks.
- They reflect the stocks that are actually available for investment, as stable shareholdings are excluded from market capitalization figures.
- There are sub-indexes for different sizes of company based on market capitalization.
- There are sub-indexes for growth and value stocks. Sub-indexes for growth and value stocks are based on P/B ratios adjusted for unrealized gains/losses on marketable securities and unrecognized retirement benefit obligations.
- The Prime Index consists of the top 1,000 stocks in the Total Market Index by market cap excluding stable shareholdings.
- Clear definitions mean that there is no arbitrariness in stock-selection methods.
- The composition of each index is reviewed once a year.

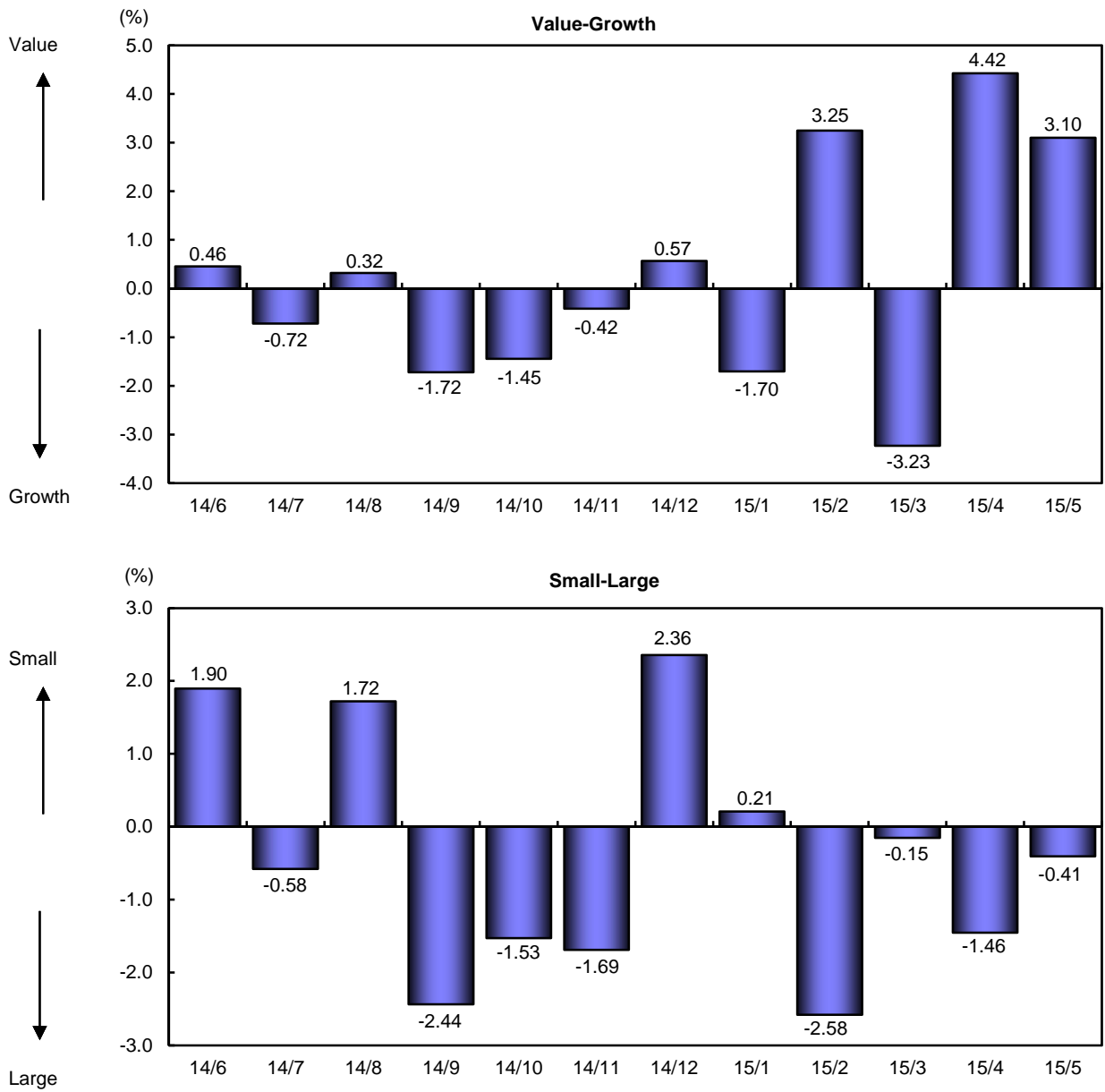

Fig. 6: Monthly performance

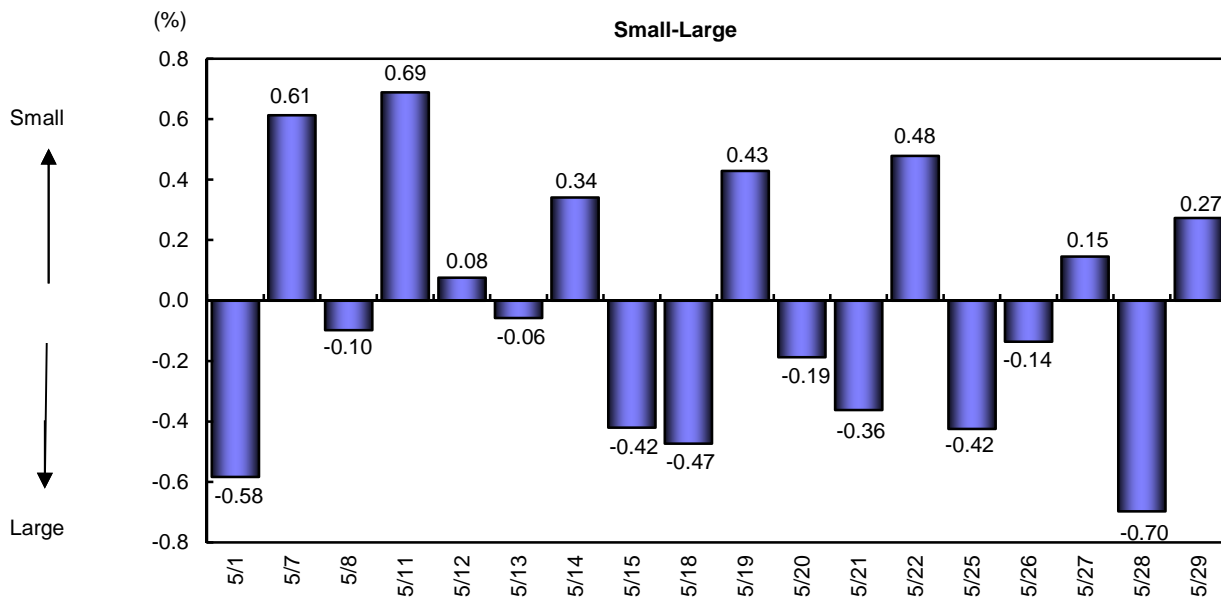
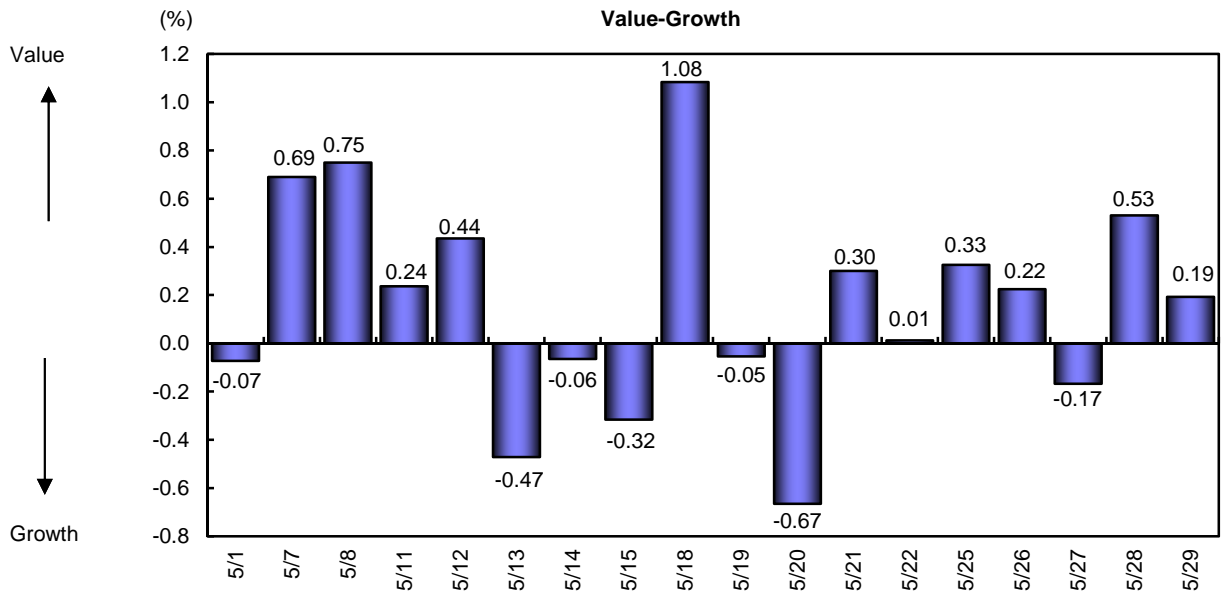

Fig. 8: Russell/Nomura Japan Equity Indexes

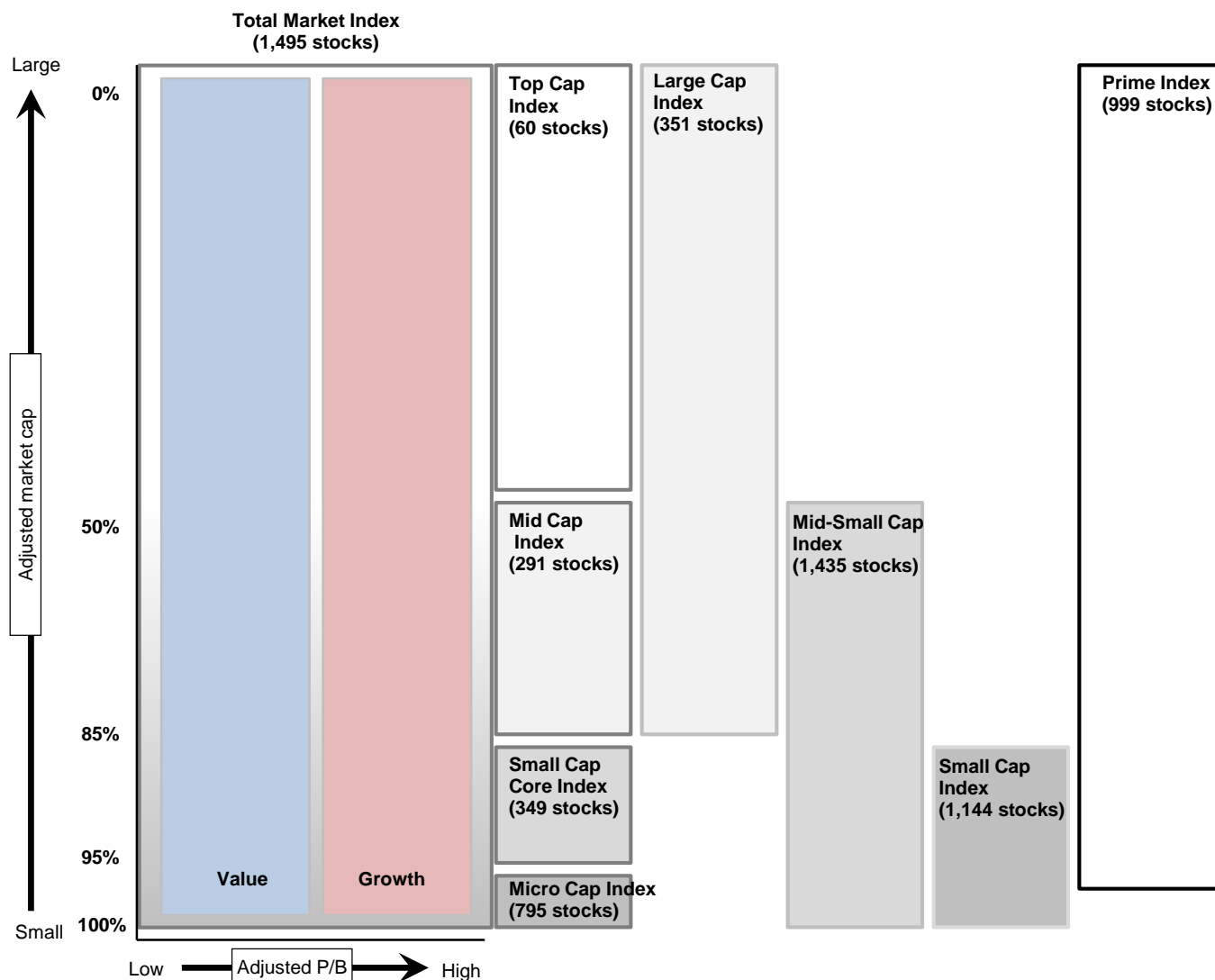

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Appendix A-1

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STOCKS

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Explanation of Nomura's equity research rating system in Japan and Asia ex-Japan prior to 21 October 2013

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Transactions involving convertible bonds are subject to a sales commission of up to 1.08% of the transaction amount (or a commission of ¥4,320 if this would be less than ¥4,320). When convertible bonds are purchased via OTC transactions (including offerings), only the purchase price shall be paid, with no sales commission charged. However, Nomura Securities may charge a separate fee for OTC transactions, as agreed with the customer. Convertible bonds carry the risk of losses owing to factors such as interest rate fluctuations and price fluctuations in the underlying stock. In addition, convertible bonds denominated in foreign currencies also carry the risk of losses owing to factors such as foreign exchange rate fluctuations.

When bonds are purchased via public offerings, secondary distributions, or other OTC transactions with Nomura Securities, only the purchase price shall be paid, with no sales commission charged. When inflation-indexed JGBs are purchased via public offerings, secondary distributions (uridashi deals), or other OTC transactions with Nomura Securities, only the purchase price shall be paid, with no sales commission charged. Inflation-indexed JGBs carry the risk of losses, as prices fluctuate in line with changes in market interest rates and fluctuations in the nationwide consumer price index. The notional principal of inflation-indexed JGBs changes in line with the rate of change in nationwide CPI inflation from the time of its issuance. The amount of the coupon payment is calculated by multiplying the coupon rate by the notional principal at the time of payment. The maturity value is the amount of the notional principal when the issue becomes due. For J117 and subsequent issues, the maturity value shall not undercut the face amount. Purchases of investment trusts (and sales of some investment trusts) are subject to a purchase or sales fee of up to 5.4% of the transaction amount. Also, a direct cost that may be incurred when selling investment trusts is a fee of up to 2.0% of the unit price at the time of redemption. Investment trust unit prices fluctuate owing to price fluctuations in the underlying assets and to foreign exchange rate fluctuations. As such, investment trusts carry the risk of losses.
